BOTH APPLICATIONS OPEN ON OCTOBER 1st EACH YEAR

WHO?	Seniors-Class of 2021
WHEN?	Do your 2021-22 FAFSA/ORSAA on or shortly after October 1st, 2020 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reapply on or after October 1st each year you're in college
WHY?	Apply to get money to help fund your post-high dreams! <i>Even if you don't qualify for the free money you don't have to pay back (Pell Grant), you might be eligible for loans, scholarships/grants from your college or work study.</i> Most scholarships require you to submit a FAFSA or ORSAA to determine financial need

Parents and students should work on the 2021-22 FAFSA/ORSAA together!

Parent & Student info is required until the student is 24 years old (in most cases)

WHAT YOU NEED:

- **Social Security Cards** or
- **Permanent Resident cards** (USCIS/green card), if you have one
- **2019 Federal Income Tax Returns for parent(s) & student(s):** if parent(s) and student(s) worked and filed tax returns in 2019
- **Financial Information**
Checking/Savings account balances, investments, business records, assets, rental property, child support, untaxed income records etc.
- **FSA ID#** (FAFSA only; not available for ORSAA)-allows you to sign/submit your FAFSA electronically
FSA ID TIP: Apply for your FSA IDs before coming to a support session if you can. The FSA ID process can take almost as much time as the FAFSA!

- 1. Gather your documents**
- 2. Create an FSA ID (FAFSA only):** www.fsaaid.gov
The student and one parent need to create their own separate, unique FSA IDs to sign and submit the FAFSA electronically.
- 3. Complete the application**

 ORSAA www.oregonstudentaid.gov
